### **Brian Part, star of the 70's Michael Landon "Little House on the Prairie" TV series and co-star of Disney's "Return to Witch Mountain" was rushed to the hospital in serious condition**

Brian Part, best known for his role as "Carl Sanderson Edwards" playing youngest son to Victor French (Mr. Edwards) in the 1970's Michael Landon "Little House on the Prairie" TV series with Melissa Gilbert was rushed to the hospital this past Monday in serious condition. Brian has starred in a numerous films in the 70's including "Return to Witch Mountain" as a goon with Kim Richards.

Part, 47 had suffered an injury in 1998 while working on the American Disability Act brining all Olive Garden restaurants to ADA code. Since his accident in 1998 Part has been left disabled and battling for his life with the California State Workman's Compensation Insurance Company. The state insurance company has been interfering to the extent of breaking laws, forging records, authorizing lethal doses of medication, denying treatments to qualify medical examiners of the State of California and at one time had stopped all income while Parts wife was pregnant with twins at which time the California State Workman's Compensation Insurance Company authorized Part's fourth surgery the day after the surgery Parts wife miscarried the twins believed by her gynecologist caused by stress with her situation with, Part.

Most recent, Part has lost 42 pounds in two months which has been averaging a loss of two pounds a day. When sent to the hospital the insurance company wanted Part to wait two months so he could see one of their doctors. If Part was to wait, he would be dead. Part cannot eat solid food and is barely holding liquids down. Once again, thanks to the helping hands of Henry Mayo Hospital in Santa Clarita, California, Brian Part is currently being treated and is in stable condition for the moment.

Brian is afraid of what will happen next. The California State Workman's Compensation Insurance Company has played God with his life the last eleven years and most recently fears that his adjuster could be a serial killer based on a rumor that a serial killer has been found working for the California State Workman's Compensation Insurance Company for the past twenty years.
